

# eduroam - Connect Windows 8 RT

These instructions explain how to connect a Windows RT tablet computer (aka "Windows 8 ARM") to the **eduroam** wireless network. *If your Windows 8 computer is not an ARM / RT device you should follow [these instructions instead](#).*

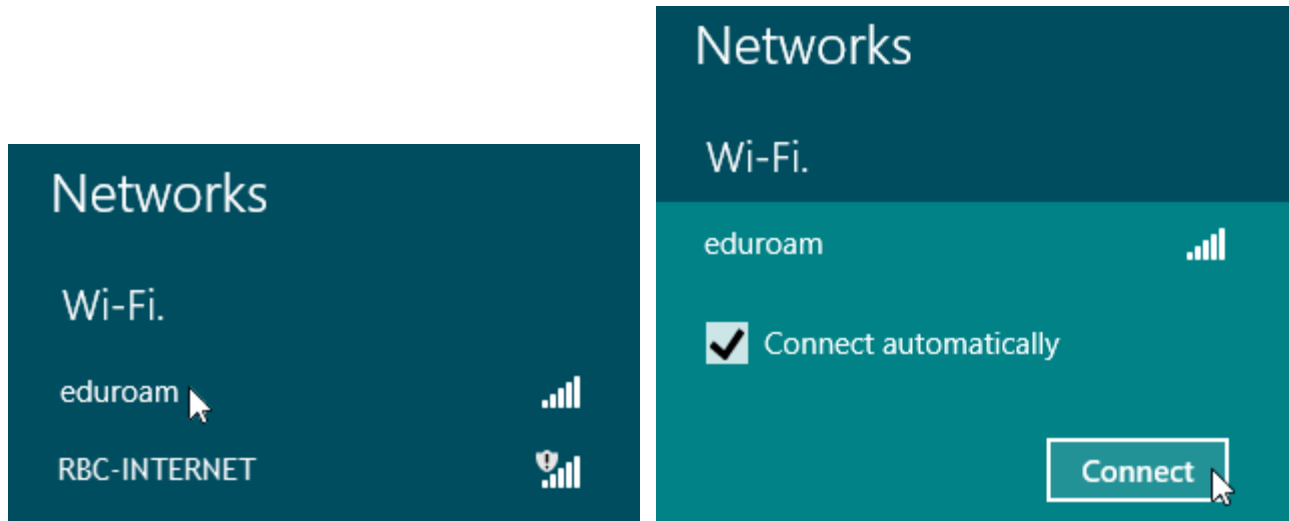
## Step-by-step guide

Download and run [the eduroam Windows RT set-up wizard](#)

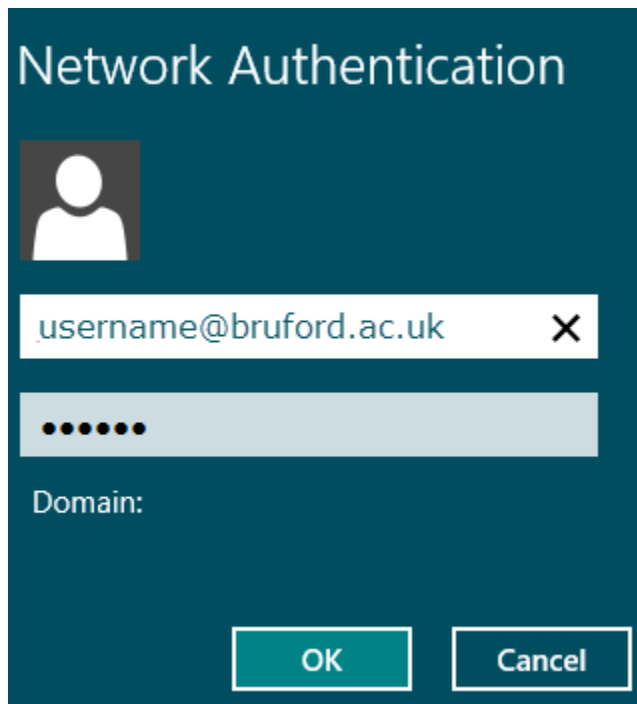
*N.B. If you have downloaded the wizard in the past, delete the copy you have, and download it again from the link above. This will ensure you are using the latest version.*

Click **Yes** if you are prompted about installing the **Comodo AddTrust External CA Root** certificate

Once the set-up wizard has completed, choose **eduroam** from the list of available wireless networks, and click **connect**



Enter your RBC username with **@bruford.ac.uk** on the end e.g.[ab12345@bruford.ac.uk](#)



Enter your password, and click **Ok**
