

# eduroam - Connect Windows 7 or Vista

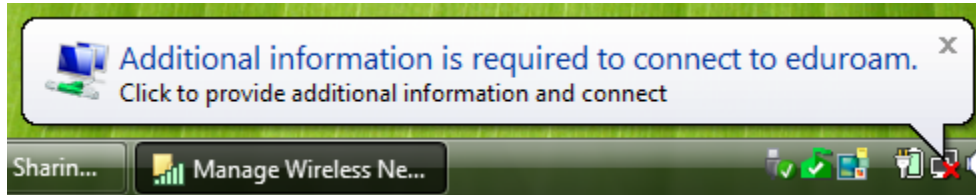
These instructions explain how to connect a Windows 7 / Windows Vista computer to the **eduroam** wireless network.

## Step-by-step guide

Download and run [the eduroam Windows 7 / Vista set-up wizard](#)

*N.B. If you have downloaded the wizard in the past, delete the copy you have, and download it again from the link above. This will ensure you are using the latest version.*

When the yellow bubble pops up, click on it and enter your Bristol username with **@bruford.ac.uk** added on to the end, for example [ab1234@bruford.ac.uk](#)



If the bubble doesn't appear, check that:

- The wireless functionality in your computer is properly enabled
- You are at a [location with good signal strength](#)

If the bubble continually appears, check that:

- You have remembered to add **@bruford.ac.uk** on to the end of your username.
- You are typing your Bristol password correctly
